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### Theorybin reply to this trusted acquaintance. June 15, 2018

Thanks much for your emails! It is amazing to me that I can be too busy for quick replies, but these responses are high on my list, when I get the message of what others perceive.

I don't know precisely which item you were referring to on Paul, but my studies have revealed in dozens of ways that he taught exactly the Pharisee Doctrine. He often repeated that he was the Pharisee of the Pharisee, and the Messiah in all of Mathew 23 gave his view of the Pharisee traditions of the Talmud.

The Talmud Mishna has 18 Treatises out of 62, that are listed on my website. This is a large file 326 pages 1.5 meg MISHNA-Talmud.pdf

These are Man's Laws written in and after Babylon, and not always agreeable to Torah Laws. They are answers to specific questions followed by the rabbinical quorum, then and now. Topics are on Prayers, Rules of the Sabbath and Festivals, Marriage, Kosher Food, Inheritance, Contracts, and Dowries. The rest of the 62 Treatises, are not available for public viewing anywhere. (Possibly relating to priest duties)

Read the Talmud Mishna sometime, and you will recognize that this is exactly what Paul taught, which was NEVER taught in the Bible before. That is exactly what the Messiah warned us to avoid in Matthew 23.

Peter warned us that Paul's teachings twisted the scriptures to destruction. Peter & James stated he was like the story of Balaam (Numbers 22), who was given an order to bless Israel. He did that, but then taught the Moab king to vex Israel. (2Pet 2:15. Rev 2:14)

James taught exactly opposite what Paul taught, and he was killed and Peter jailed immediately after Paul returned from Antioch. Take out the chapter break between 11 &12 of Acts. Paul was sent to the elders by Antioch, and immediately Herod vexed the

church. Paul did not take the Antioch treasures to the Apostles, he took them to Herod. Then Herod removed those who spoke against Paul.

Remember that Paul was the Prince, next in line to be king. His mother was Herodias who he introduced to Caesar and the Senate in chapter 16 of Romans. Herodias was married to Herod Antipas (Paul's father) and then to Herod Philip. When he speaks of the "laws of his fathers" he is speaking of Herods, the Pharisee kings.

How did Paul become an apostle? City Iconium debated the miracles of the <u>apostles</u>, Barnabas and Paul (Acts 14:4, Rev 2:2) Barnabas and Paul were both identified as apostles (Greek messengers) (Acts 14:14) How did Barnabas become an apostle?

There are only 12 true Apostles; These are the two False Apostles in Revelation 2:2, and one is the 1<sup>st</sup> Beast in Revelation 13. Paul is **the Beast, that will be charging you with offences**, which is what he does in most all of his teachings.

To highlight Paul's conversion, to stop him from destroying Jews of Damascus. For God has put in their hearts to fulfill his will, and to agree, and <u>give their kingdom</u> <u>unto the beast</u>, until the words of God shall be fulfilled. (1<sup>st</sup> Beast of Rev 13:4-8, 17:17)

In Tribulation time, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Beast will build an image of the 1<sup>st</sup> Beast, and ALL those who honor the 1<sup>st</sup> Beast will NOT be written in the book of life. **Do not take this lightly. It is written as a grave warning!** The 2<sup>nd</sup> Beast is the false messiah, who will build an image to Paul, and bring it to life. The masses will see the miracles, and follow the false messiah.

Rev 2:13 said that Antipas (Paul's father) lived at the seat of Satan, and holds his name. That is where Paul Antipas lived for 2 years (Acts 23) after he was dragged from the Temple. Rev 2:13 is translated badly, saying Antipas was a martyr; but it really says that Antipas is the one who martyred Me.

My calculations start the 2<sup>nd</sup> Beast on Trumpets of 2023.

the statement using the e-Sword computer program. The KJV+ tab allows you to see each word with the Strong's number beside it. When you run your pointer over the number, it gives definition of the Greek word of each number.

Original KJV of John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Re-Interpreted KJV+ of John 3:16 – (words in brackets, inserted for readability) And Yahweh will love this creation wherefore (he) delivered His own Son. Intending any that trust and honor others (of) those without destruction, (will) indeed posess eternal life.
